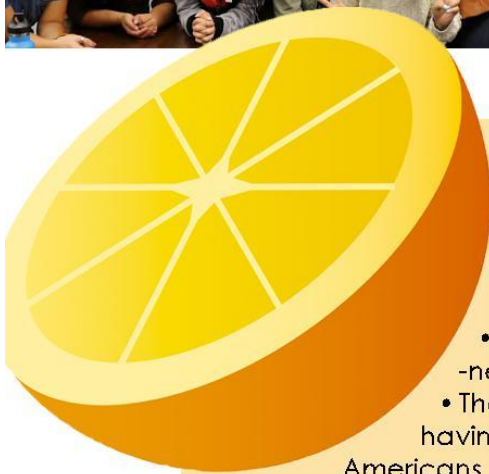
- Laguna woods (271%), Irvine (99%), and San Clemente (98%) have had the largest increases of Asian Americans.

Orange County as a whole

- Orange County is home to the third largest Asian American population nationwide with nearly 600,000 Asian Americans and over 19,000 Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders.
- From 2000 to 2010, AAIs are the fastest growing demographic in Orange County in most subcategories.
- Orange County is the third largest Asian American owned businesses in the US.
- The economic crisis continues to impact AAIs in Orange County, having unemployment increase by 123% and the number of Asian Americans living in poverty increased by 51% in the years 2007-2012
- The Asian American population has the most immigrants than any other racial group in Orange County
